### Final Conference in Opava

On Friday 20th February, project partners gathered in Opava, Czechia for the final transnational meeting of the project. This meeting provided an important opportunity to review the final implementation stages, confirm that all deliverables have been completed successfully, and reflect together on the achievements of the partnership over the project's lifetime.

After the meeting, the final conference was held, which was attended by over 40 youth workers, and members of the wider community. The highlight of the event was the screening of one short film created during the Czech piloting phase.



Across the project, the partnership successfully:

- Delivered 1 transnational training activity for youth workers
- Conducted workshops reaching 70 young people across partner countries
- Trained 35 youth workers
- Presented the project to over 160 stakeholders

## Wellbeing Workshops & Short Films

The piloting phase of the project has now successfully concluded, with around 70 young people across partner countries taking part in hands-on workshops.

These sessions focused on wellbeing, peer support, and creative digital storytelling, giving participants the opportunity to explore important topics while developing practical and creative skills.

Working in small teams, young people from each partner country produced four short films, resulting in a collection of 24 youth-created films. These videos addressed issues that matter to young people today, including wellbeing, peer pressure, making healthy choices, and supporting friends.

Beyond the technical skills gained, the experience had a strong personal impact on participants. Young people built confidence, strengthened teamwork skills, and developed a stronger sense of their own voice and ability to communicate important messages. For many, this was their first experience of creating a film, sharing their ideas publicly, and taking part in an international project.
